THE LEGAL PROFESSION ACT

**THE LEGAL PROFESSION (ENROLMENT AND PRACTISING CERTIFICATE
FEES (AMENDMENT) RULES, 2010**

In exercise of the powers conferred on section 4 of the Judicature (Rules of Court) Act, and by virtue of section 4 of the Legal Profession Act, and of every other power hereunto enabling, the following Rules are hereby made:—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Legal Profession (Enrolment and Practising Certificate Fees) (Amendment) Rules, 2010 and shall be read and construed as one with the Legal Profession (Enrolment and Practising Certificate Fees) Rules, 1971 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Rules) and shall come into operation the first day of January, 2011.

2. Part II of the First Schedule to the Principal Rules is hereby deleted and the following substituted therefor

| (1) Attorneys-at-Law of less than two years' standing | \$5,000.00 |
| (2) Attorneys-at-Law of two years' standing but less than five years' standing | \$8,000.00 |
| (3) Attorneys-at-Law of five years standing but less than ten years' standing, reckoned in the case of those who were formerly barristers or solicitors from the date of admission to practise in Jamaica | \$12,000.00 |
| (4) Attorneys-at-Law of ten years' standing but less than fifteen years' standing, reckoned in the case of those who were formerly barristers or solicitors from the date of admission to practise in Jamaica | \$15,000.00 |
| (5) Attorneys-at-Law of fifteen years' standing and over reckoned in the case of those who were formerly barristers or solicitors from the date of admission to practise in Jamaica | \$20,000.00 |
